

Marijuana Safety in the Home

Alliance for Healthy Communities is dedicated to keeping kids healthy and safe. This includes protecting children from the negative impacts of marijuana. If you have marijuana or marijuana products in your home, take the below precautions to ensure the safety of your children and young visitors to your home:

- Keep marijuana up and away - pick a place your children cannot reach
- Put marijuana away every time you use it - never leave it out, even if you anticipate using it again soon
- Consider purchasing a medication lock box or bag - children can easily access marijuana products in their original packaging
- Talk to your children about marijuana - teach your children about safety
- Ask other parents if they have marijuana products in their home before sending your child out to a friend's house
- Be prepared in case of an emergency - call the Poison Control Center at 800-222-1222 right away if you think your child has consumed marijuana products
